## Map of Rothamsted Farm

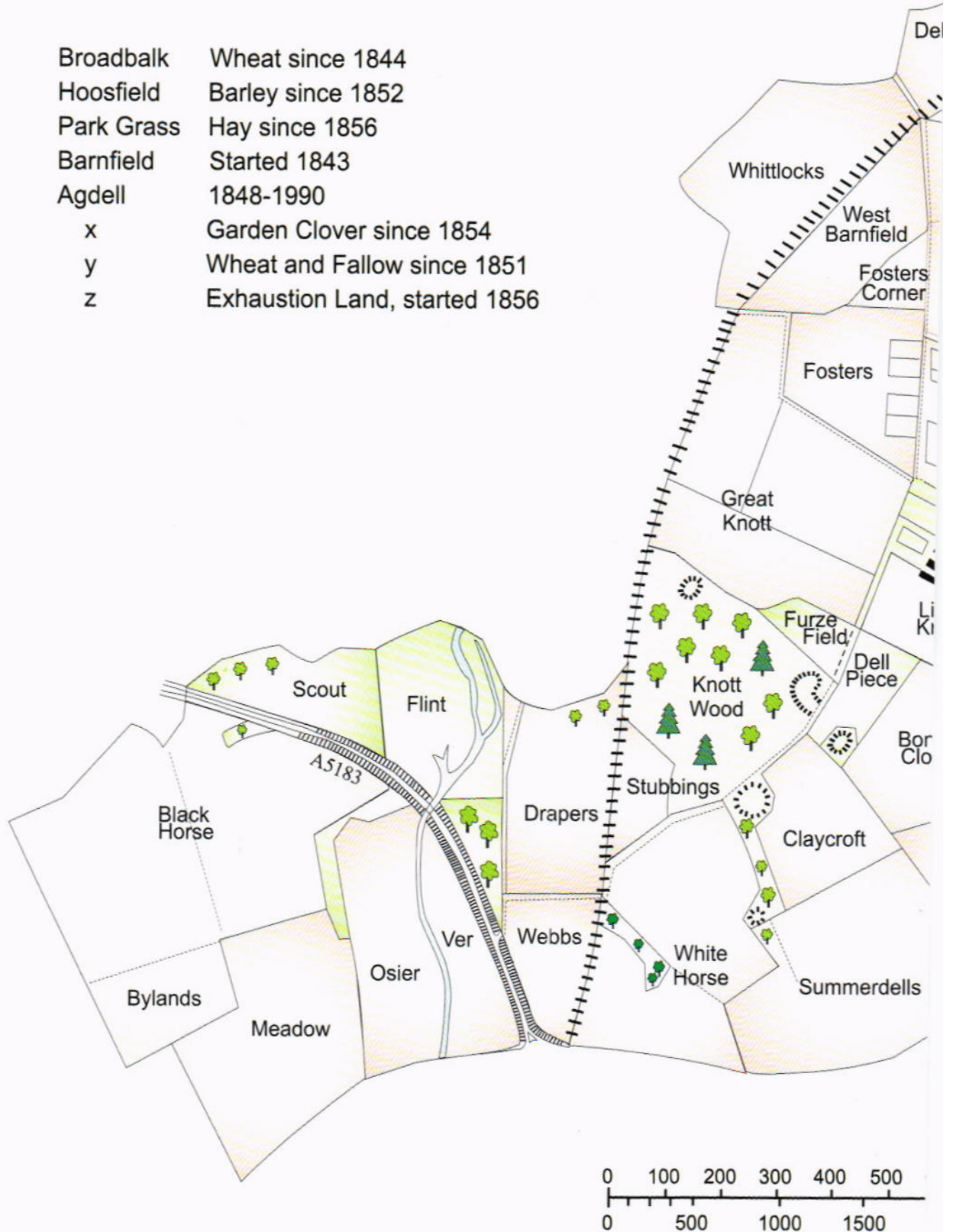

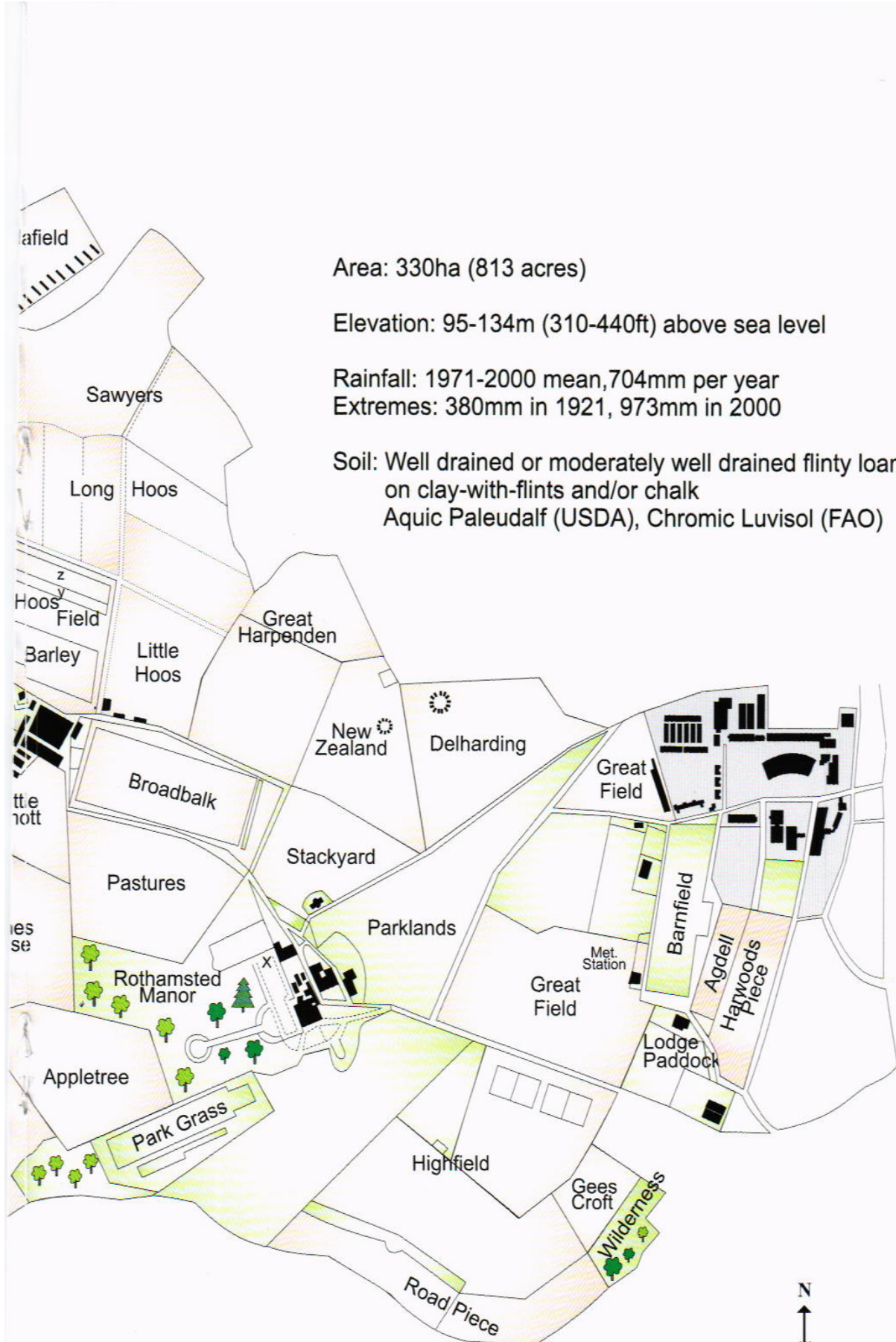

Broadbalk	Wheat since 1844
Hoosfield	Barley since 1852
Park Grass	Hay since 1856
Barnfield	Started 1843
Agdell	1848-1990
x	Garden Clover since 1854
y	Wheat and Fallow since 1851
z	Exhaustion Land, started 1856





Area: 330ha (813 acres)

Elevation: 95-134m (310-440ft) above sea level

Rainfall: 1971-2000 mean, 704mm per year  
Extremes: 380mm in 1921, 973mm in 2000

Soil: Well drained or moderately well drained flinty loams  
on clay-with-flints and/or chalk  
Aquic Paleudalf (USDA), Chromic Luvisol (FAO)
