

The Bureau, one of ten Commonwealth Agricultural Bureaux, was established at Rothamsted in 1929. Administratively and financially the Bureaux is distinct from the Station, but the two work closely together. The Director of the Station is Consultant Director of the Soil Bureau.

The function of the Bureau is to provide an information service for workers in soil science, primarily throughout the Commonwealth but also throughout the world.

Soils and Fertilizers—a monthly abstract journal covering the world literature of soil science, soil-plant relationships, fertilizer technology and fertilizer use.
