Rothamsted Experimental Station Map

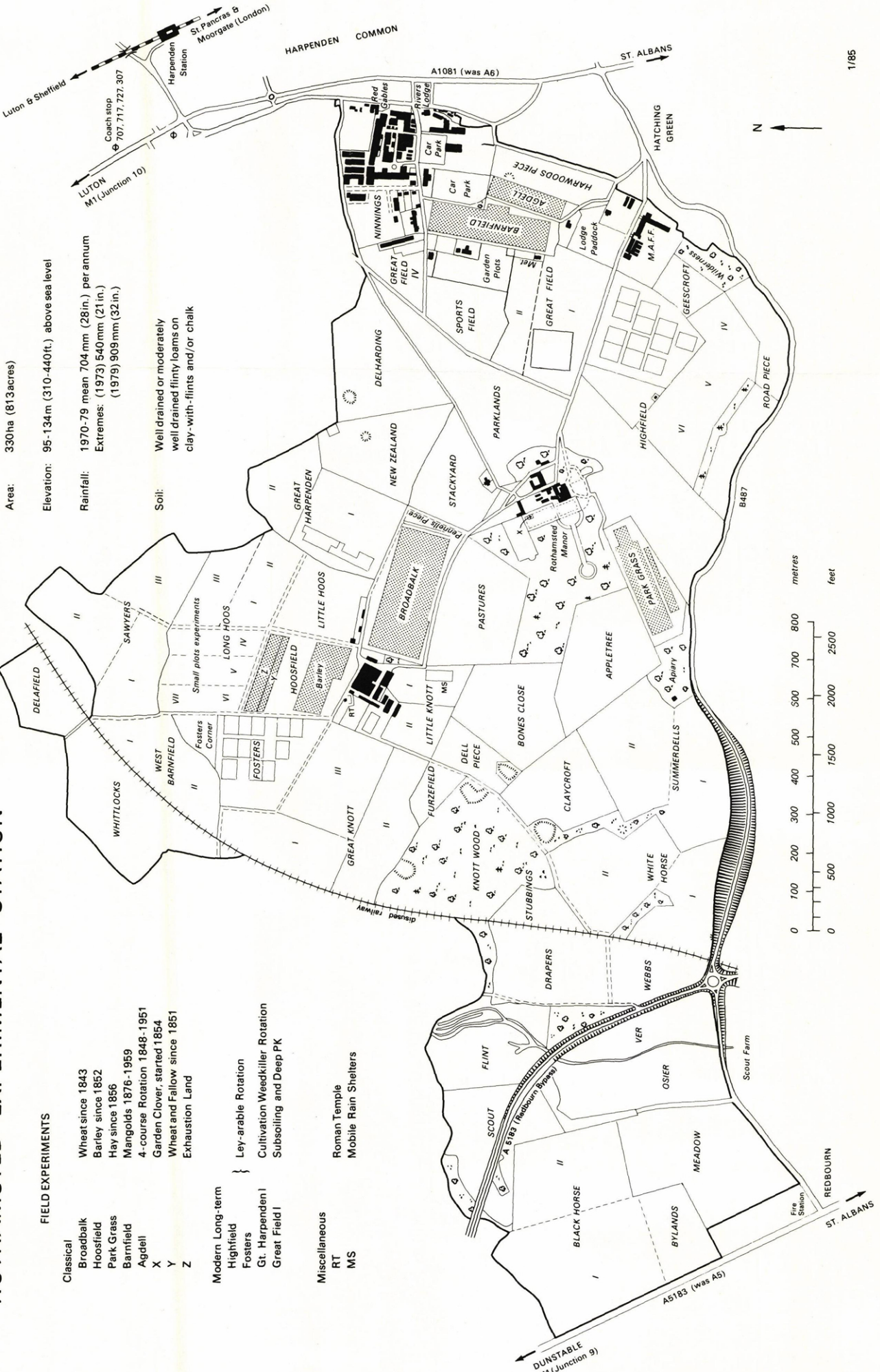
