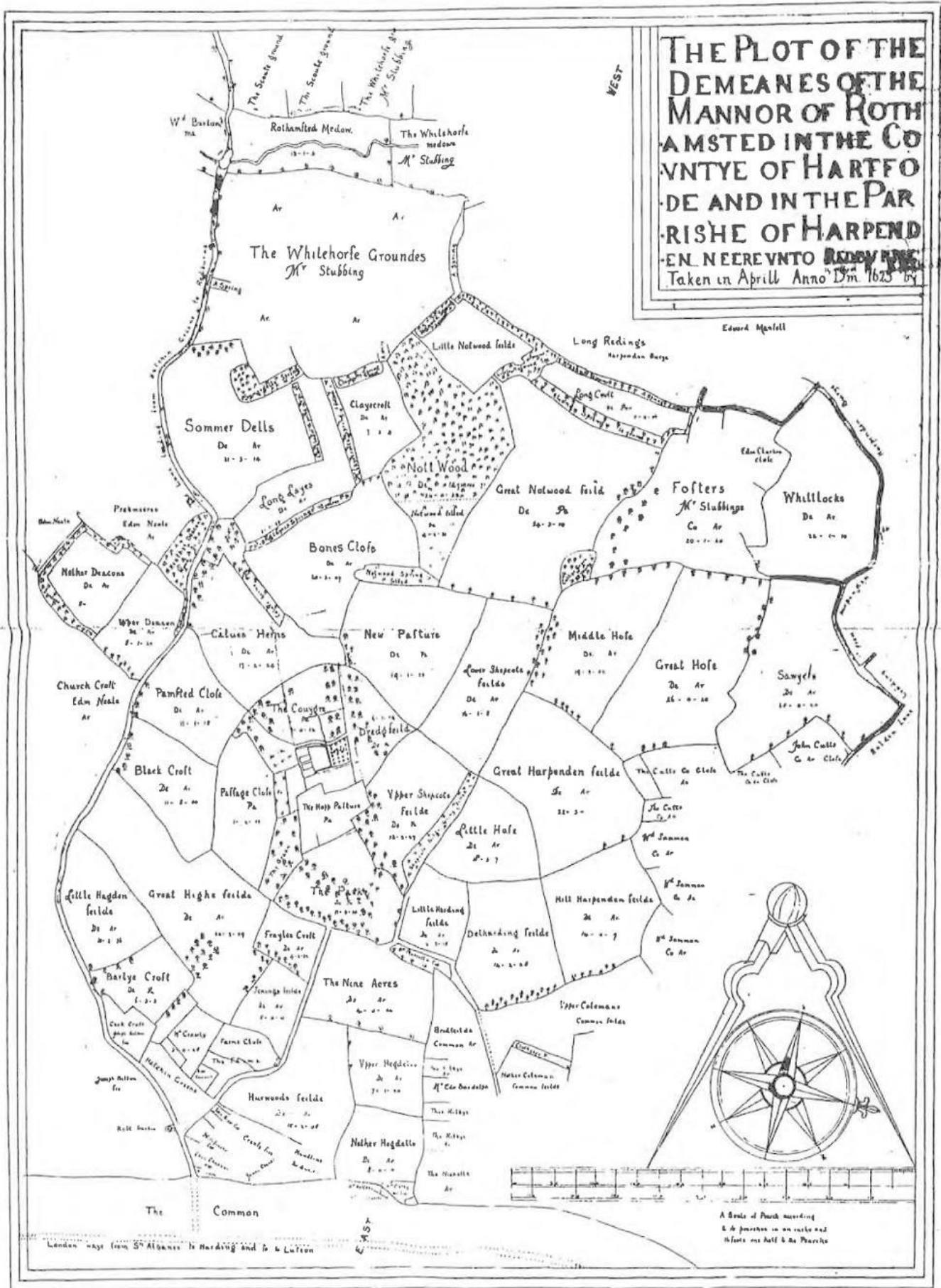

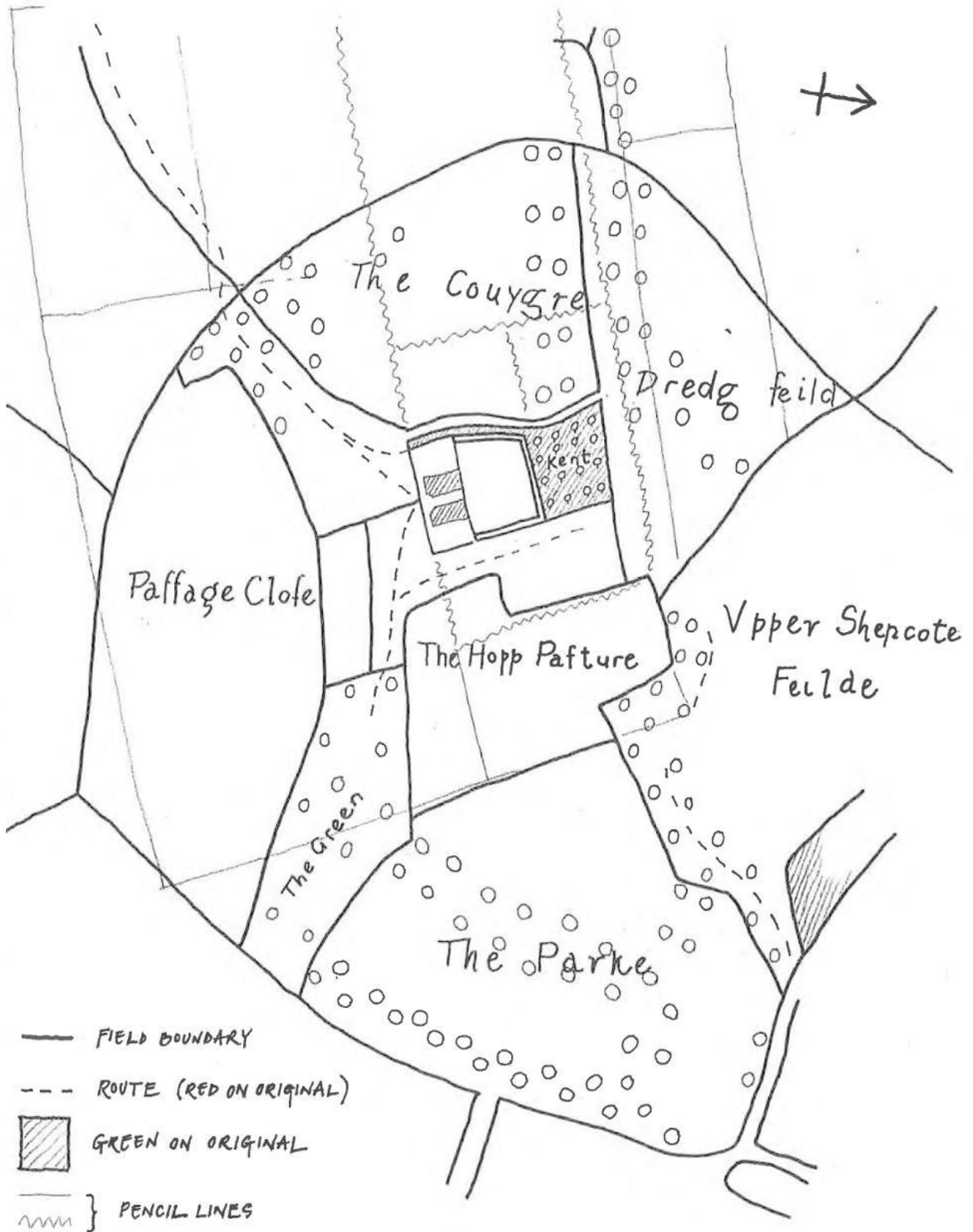

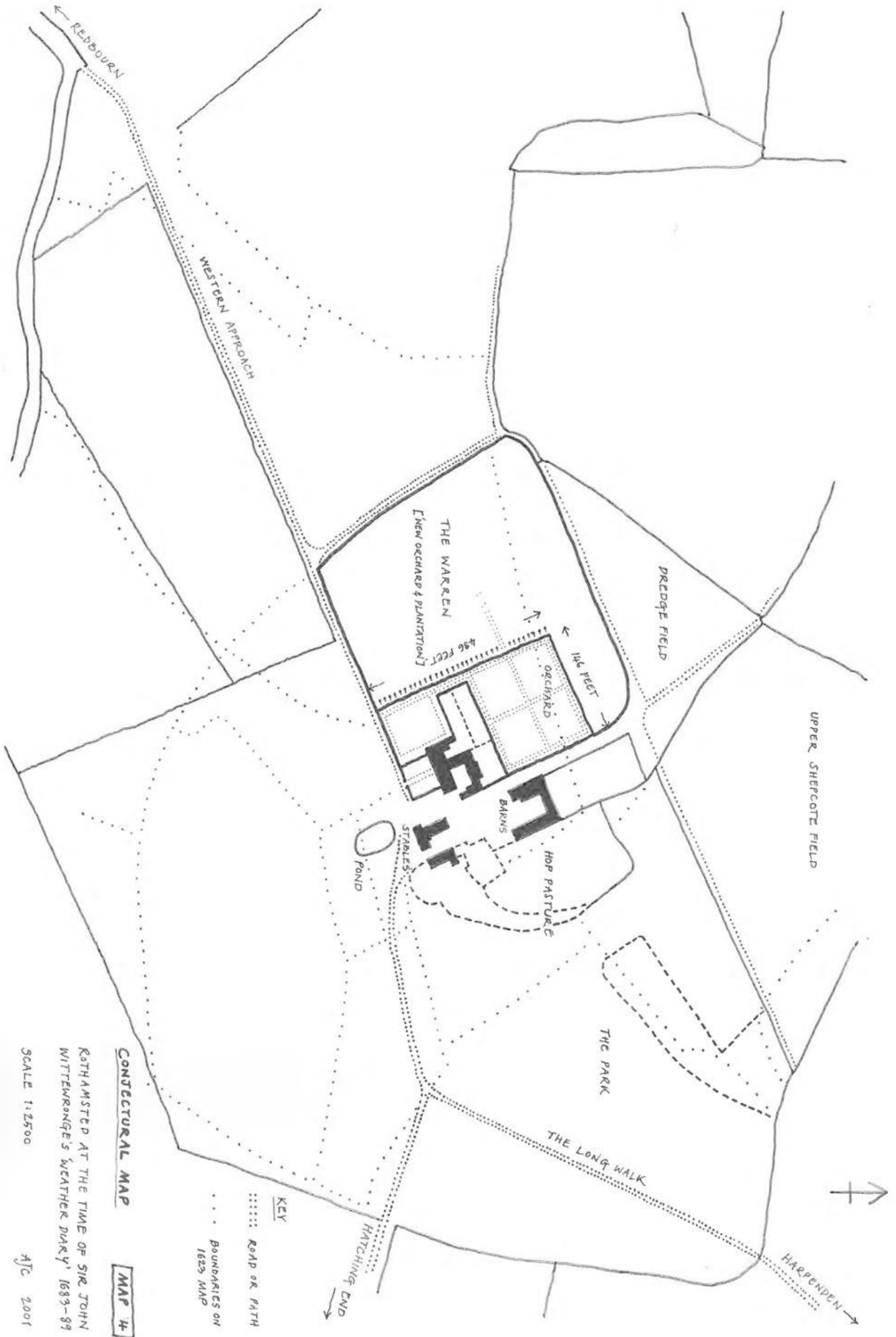

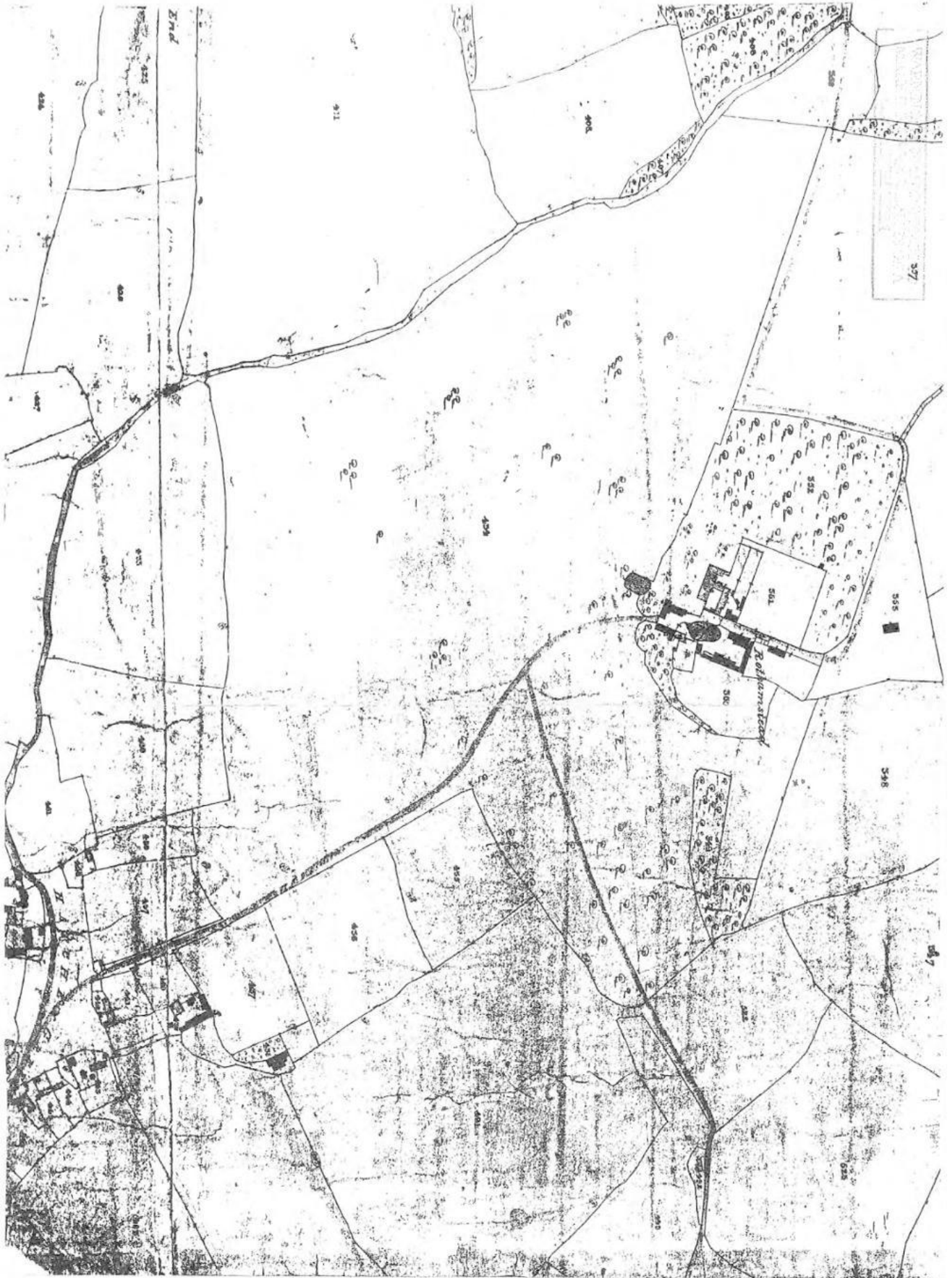


'THE PLOT OF THE MANNOR OF ROTHAMSTED... 1623'

TRACING AT FULL SCALE





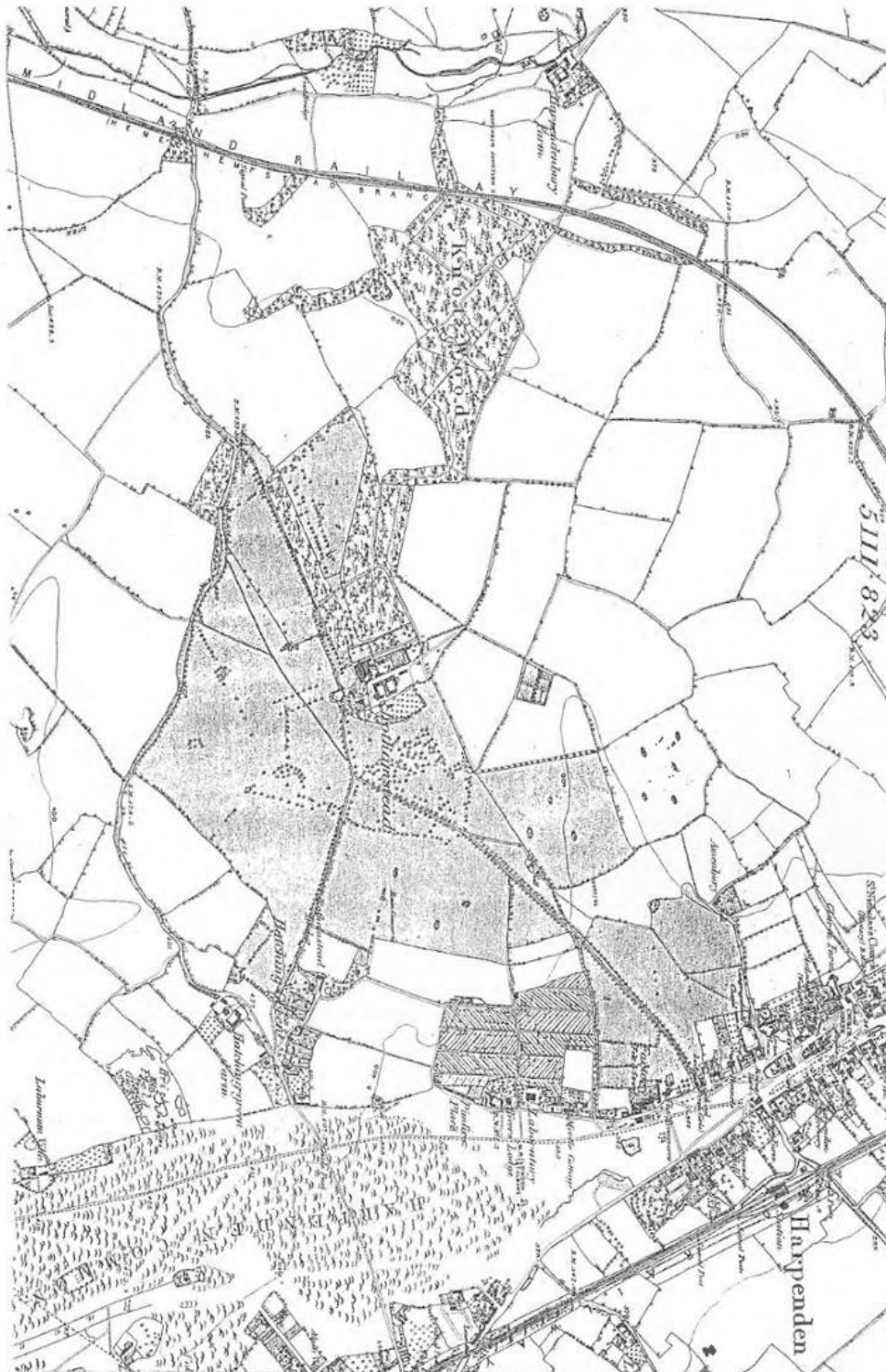

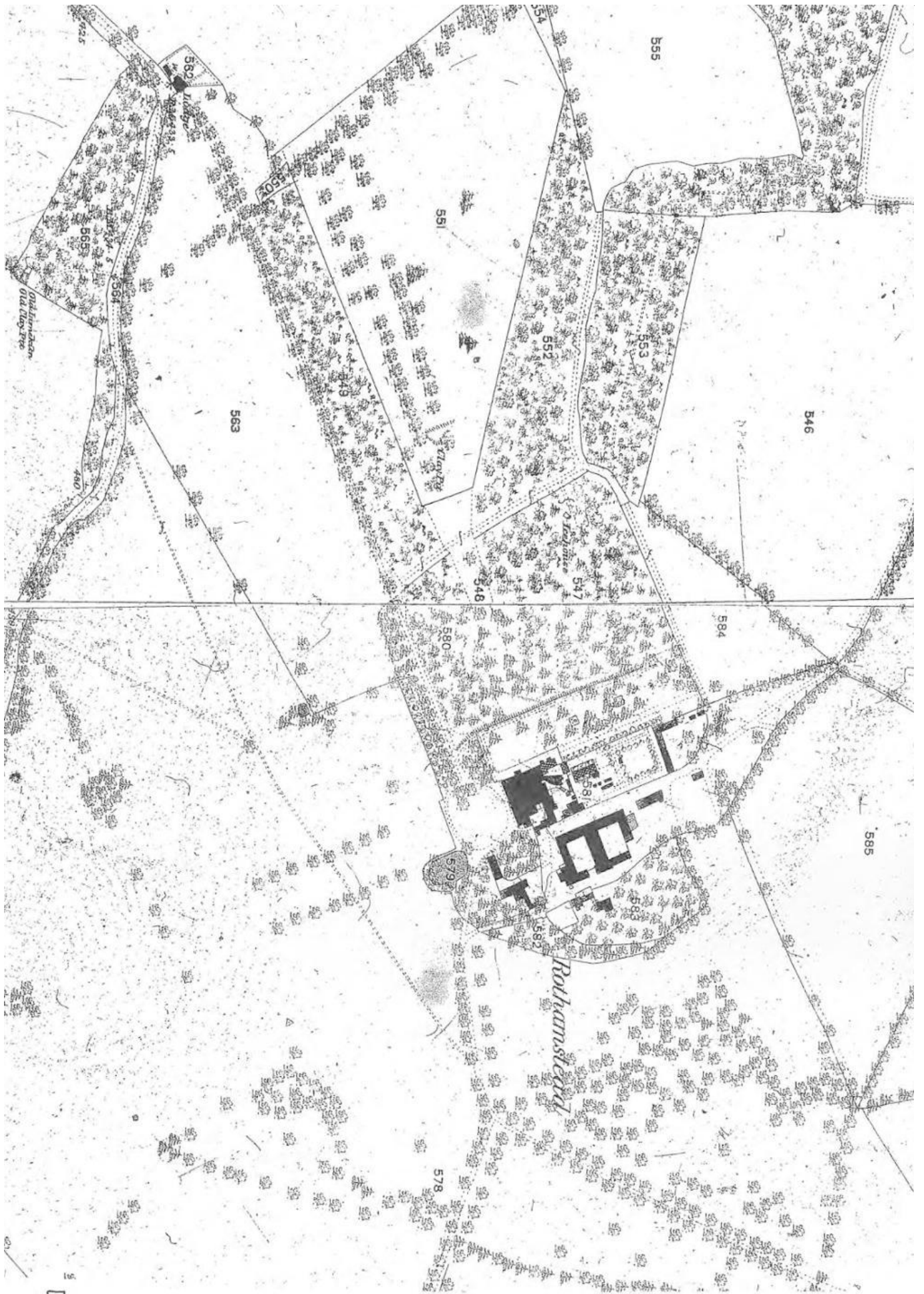

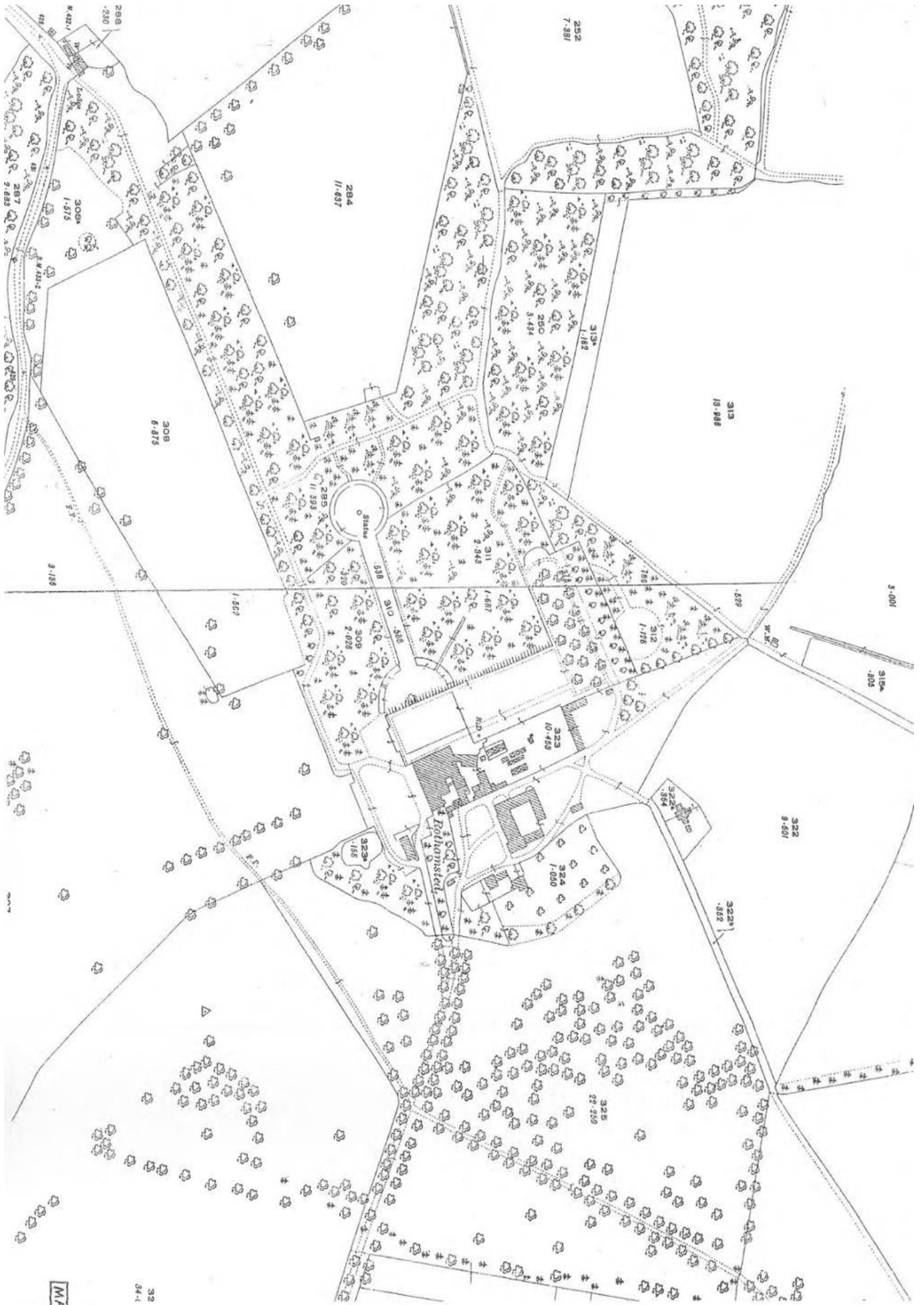

ORDNANCE SURVEY, 1ST EDITION, 25", Surv. 1878, publ. 1884.



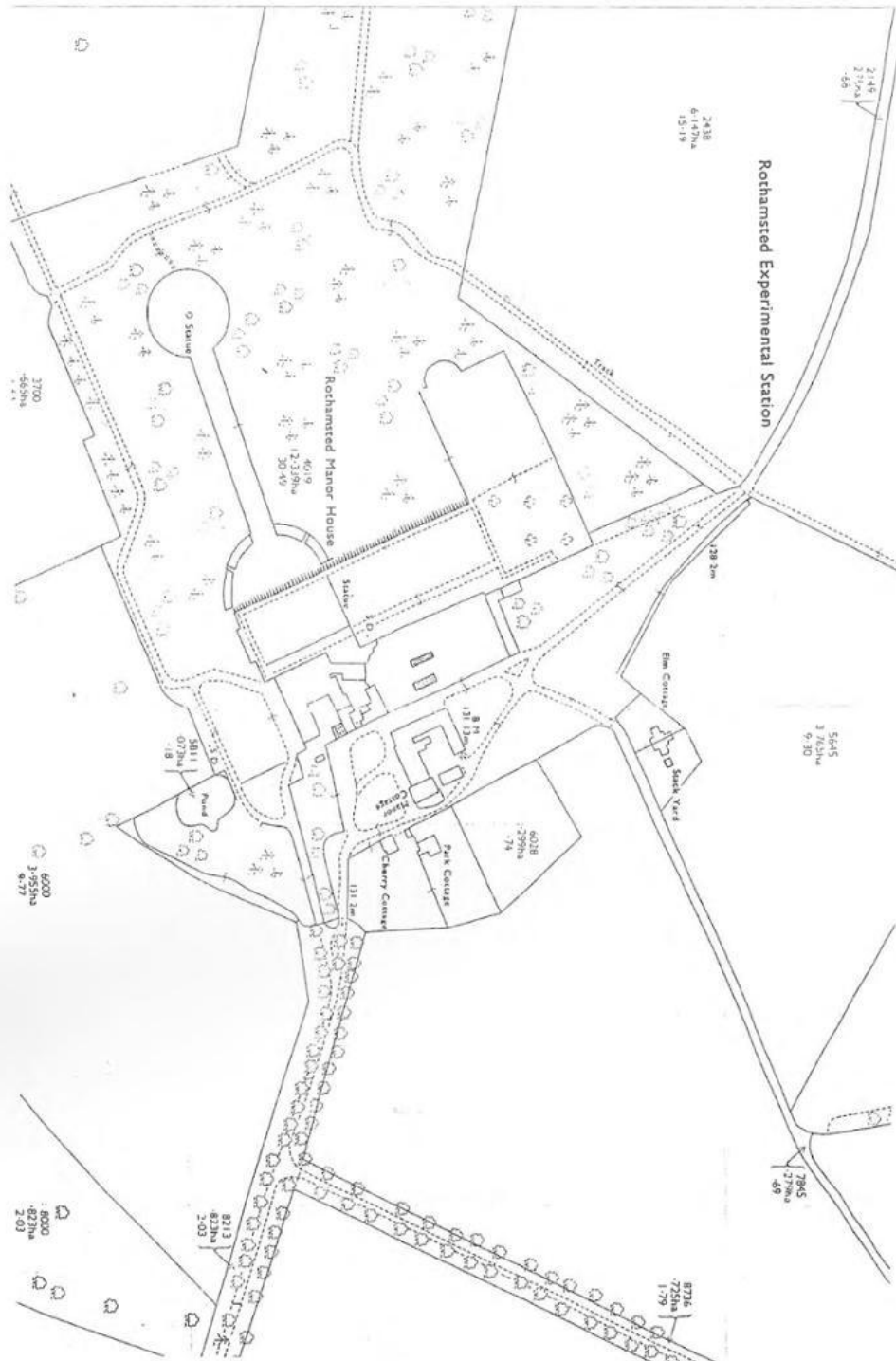

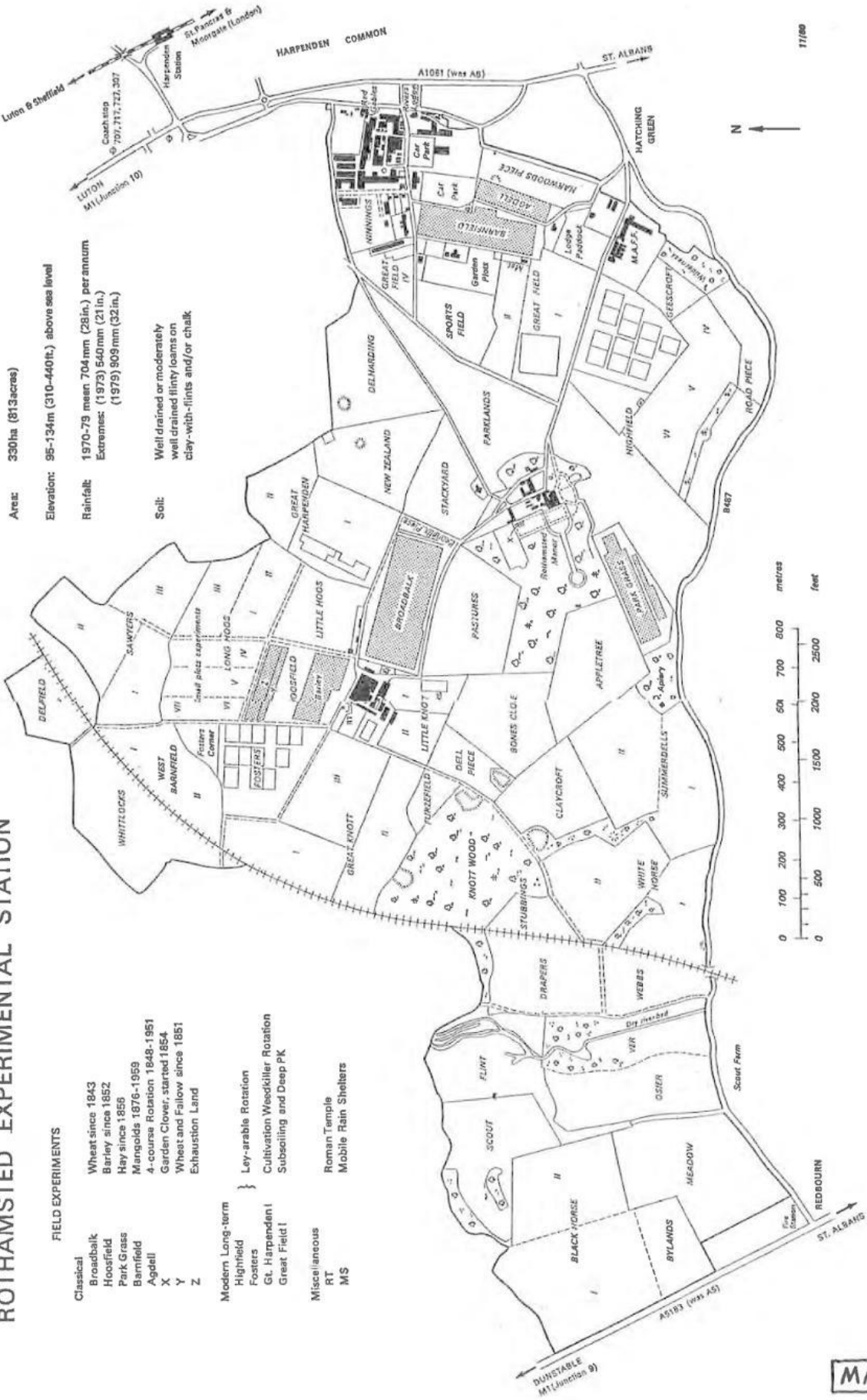
